

## TMX Visiting Professorship

The DeGroote School of Business at McMaster University invites applications for a one-year visiting position, rank open, in the Finance and Business Economics Area. The position will commence July 1, 2011.

### Job Description

The chosen candidate will hold the TMX Visiting Professorship, and will have an established academic research record in the area of capital markets. An interest in market microstructure would be an asset. Evidence of an applicant's record will include success in attracting research funding and in publication of research results in major scholarly outlets. The TMX Visiting Professor will be expected to contribute to the School's academic programs. An appointment to the Professorship will be for a one-year period, with the possibility of renewal for additional terms.

The Finance and Business Economics Area is committed to excellence in both research and teaching, and is one of six Areas comprising the DeGroote School of Business. The School offers a number of programs at both the undergraduate and graduate levels. The Finance and Business Economics Area participates in these programs in a number of ways, including MBA specializations in Finance and Strategic Business Valuation and a Ph.D. field in Finance.
