- Canadian permanent residence

Frequently Asked Questions:

 I am currently completing my post-secondary program part-time, am I still eligible?

Yes, part-time students are eligible if they are in entering the final year or semester of study in the fall.

• I am currently in the process of completing my last year of post-secondary studies and will be graduating in the spring, can I still apply?

No, our scholarship is to fund the last year of studies, so you are no longer eligible. Students must be entering their final year of a degree or diploma program in the fall in order to apply, and confirmation of enrolment will be required before the funds are released.

I am a Canadian citizen attending a post-secondary school outside of Canada, am
I eligible for this scholarship.

No, scholarship recipients must be a Canadian permanent resident or citizen attending a Canadian post-secondary institute.
